There are currently 110 species of nationally protected animals  
Among them, 24 species are national first-level protected animals.

86 species of national second-level protected animals

It is one of the hotspots for global biodiversity conservation.

Known as "China's low-altitude areas"

Area with the highest encounter rate of rare wild animals"

In 2012, the Chengdu Giant Panda Base selected "Panda Guardians" from all over the world. Puye and two other giant panda fans stood out from 1.16 million applicants from around the world.

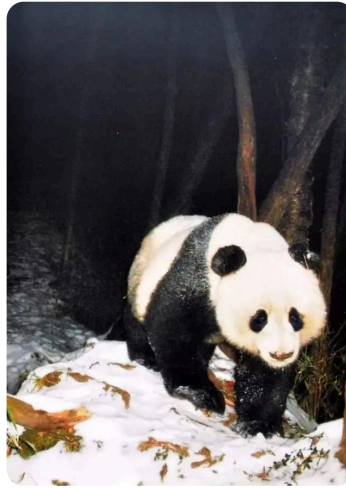
